The evening of March 3, 2011, Middleton Police arrested **Rebecca A. Reese**, 21, of Middleton, and **Lanessa L. Lattimore**, 21, of Middleton, without incident in connection with the February 28th, 2011 armed robbery at the PDQ Store at 6519 Century Avenue in Middleton. The gun was recovered. Reese is tentatively charged with armed robbery and Lattimore with being party to the armed robbery. Both are currently being held in the Dane County Jail.

On the morning of Monday, 02/28/11 at approximately 12:39am, the Middleton Police Department responded to the report of an armed robbery that occurred at the PDQ store, 6519 Century Avenue. The investigation revealed that a white female entered the store and approached the counter to make a purchase. When the clerk opened the register, the suspect produced a **black handgun** and demanded the money. She then fled eastbound through the parking lot.

The suspect is described as a **white female** in her **late teens or early twenties**. She has **brown hair** and is approximately **5'8"** and **170 pounds**. She was last seen wearing a **black hooded sweatshirt over a red hooded sweatshirt along with blue jeans and brown boots**.

Middleton Police were assisted on this case by the Dane County Sheriff's Office as well as the Town of Madison K9 unit.
