Middleton EMS and Police work together to get another drunk driver off the streets

On Friday night, Middleton Paramedics returning from a local hospital were alerted by a motorist of a person that had been passed out behind the wheel of a vehicle on University Avenue. The medics noticed the vehicle traveling all over the road and almost hitting other vehicles. The Medics immediately radioed the Middleton Police Communications Center and reported what they were witnessing.

Police Officers were notified and stopped the vehicle on Deming Way and arrested the driver, Steven E. Pyle, 27, of Madison for 3<sup>rd</sup> offense Operating While Intoxicated. Pyle was reportedly on his way to work and his blood alcohol content was over three times the legal limit. He was also cited for driving with open intoxicants.
