SUBJECT: Fleeing an Officer
INCIDENT DATE/TIME: March 6, 2012 @ 3:57 PM
LOCATION: Parmenter St & Hubbard Ave

On Sunday, May 6, 2012 at 3:57 PM, a Middleton Officer attempted to stop a vehicle for failure to stop at a stop sign.

The driver disregarded emergency lights and siren and fled at high speed. Officers did not give chase.

An alert Middleton EMS crew observed the abandoned suspect vehicle a short time later and citizens reported seeing a man running away. With this information and through investigation, Officers locate the alleged driver about two-hours later hiding in a residence on nearby Hillcrest Avenue in Middleton.



Matthew M. Pritzkow, 22, of Middleton was arrested without incident and tentatively charged with **felony fleeing an officer** and **bail jumping**. Pritzkow was also issued citations for failure to stop at a stop sign, operating with a suspended driver's license and displaying false license plates.
