An officer on patrol was approached by Gabryshak, who asked for directions to “go north.” The officer noticed that Gabryshak’s eyes were bloodshot and his speech was slurred. Gabryshak drove away before the officer was able to investigate further. As the officer began to follow him, Gabryshak then stopped in the middle of the road for no apparent reason.



Officers stopped Gabryshak, who failed field sobriety tests and said he had not been drinking alcohol or taking any drugs. He said he had only taken protein powder, pain medication and wasn’t sure what other medication he may have taken. Gabryshak was arrested for 7th offense operating under the influence of a controlled substance and was taken to the Dane County Jail.
